Cloud Learning for All: Faculty of Computing UMPSA and PETAKOM Explores Training and Certification with RunCloud Education

The Faculty of Computing UMPSA (FK) and The Computer Technology Student Association (PETAKOM) held a meeting with RunCloud Education to explore working together in cloud technology education. RunCloud shared their learning programmes from beginner to professional levels and their RunCloud Apprentice programme, which offers students industry training. They also talked about new certificates like Cloud Awareness Series and Cloud Skill Series, which will be recognised by MBOT and RunCloud.

Another idea discussed was the RC Education Regional Meetup @ UMPSA, a one-day event for IT students, new graduates, and professionals from the East Coast. The event will focus on learning, networking, and career development. About 150–200 people are expected to join. Both sides also plan to sign an agreement (MoU or MoA) to strengthen the partnership. As a first step, they will prepare a Letter of Intent (LoI) to show their commitment.

This collaboration hopes to help UMPSA students gain stronger cloud skills and more job opportunities in the growing digital field.



PETAKOM UMPSA Hand Over RM10,000 Aid to 100 FK Students for Eid Mubarak 2025 Celebration

UMPSA Vice-Chancellor Reviews Tech Upgrades at Faculty of Computing

The Vice-Chancellor of UMPSA, Professor Dr. Yatimah Alias, visited several old projects at the Faculty of Computing. The visit aimed to check the progress of the projects and how the RMK-12 RP4 budget was used. The first location was Cisco Lab 3, where 27 switches and 27 routers were bought to support teaching and learning in network systems.

The visit continued at the Structure Cabling Workshop, where she observed how a cable analyser and three splicer tools are used in data communication lessons. These tools cost a total of RM360,000. At the Server Room in the Technical Office, two new servers were installed to replace old ones. These servers are expected to improve data and system management in the faculty.

The Vice-Chancellor also took time to visit the cafeteria, the computer theatre room, and several computer labs. This visit helped her understand the current condition of the facilities and supported future planning to improve the learning environment for students and staff.



From Ideas to Papers: A Productive Day for UMPSA Postgraduates

FK hosted a hands-on research writing workshop at the Royale Ancasa Hotel in Pekan, Pahang. Bringing together 95 postgraduate students and lecturers, the event offered a focused space for participants to work on their research papers especially for those who are planning to submit the paper in ICSECS 2025.

Unlike typical workshops filled with long talks, this session was all about doing the actual writing. Students came with their ideas or early drafts and spent the day shaping them into proper research papers. With guidance from their supervisors and feedback throughout the day, many made great progress, some even finalised their paper structures.

Working in small groups created a relaxed and friendly environment where participants could exchange ideas, improve their writing, and support one another. The atmosphere was productive yet informal, making it easier to stay motivated and focused.

One of the best outcomes was the number of papers close to being ready for submission, showing how effective a practical approach can be. It was a real boost for both students and lecturers striving to publish quality research.

To make the event even more special, the faculty held a small starter kit handover ceremony. Sixty postgraduate students received kits with helpful study items like tumblers and stationery, a simple gesture to say thank you for being part of the FK.

This first-of-its-kind initiative reflects the faculty's commitment to nurturing research and celebrating its students. It wasn't just a workshop but, it was a shared journey toward growth, learning, and academic success.
